

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I get from Guatemala City Airport to Antigua?

Transportation from Guatemala City Airport to Antigua can be arranged through [Porta Hotel](#), ALDEA's trusted travel partner, Highland Tours (email: highlandtoursqt@gmail.com), or another transportation provider of your choice. We recommend arranging transportation in advance.

What is the dress code?

There is no formal dress code. Dress to celebrate! We'll have marimba, dinner, and dancing, so wear something you feel comfortable celebrating in.

Is the event accessible?

Antigua has cobblestone streets and some uneven sidewalks, which may present accessibility challenges. Porta Hotel's facilities are accessible, with ramps and guest rooms available on the first floor. If you have specific accessibility needs, please contact us in advance so we can help.

What is the agenda for the evening?

The celebration will take place from approximately 5:00–10:00 p.m. The evening will include:

- 5:00 p.m. – Welcome reception with marimba and an outdoor gallery walk highlighting ALDEA's history
- Dinner and program
- Dancing with a DJ

Can I bring children?

The event is geared primarily toward adults and includes several hours of sitting and listening during dinner and the program. However, we leave this decision up to each guest based on what will work best for their family.

Can I purchase a table?

Yes! Tables seat 10 people, and a full table can be purchased for \$1,450.

Is alcohol included?

Your registration includes one complimentary alcoholic beverage ticket for beer or wine. Limited wine will also be served with dinner. Additional beer and wine will be available for purchase at a cash bar.
