

Just a reminder to everyone:




As I said through out the year we had more than enough problems with Comcast and are still continuing to still have some problems. I know you all have heard this over and over but we are working very closely with Comcast to resolve these problems. The main problem has been the Comcast modems are getting jammed up and must be manually reset. Just very recently we have made a change that we are now able to reset these modems remotely and not going directly into the clubhouse to do this. If we do not get the signal from the Comcast modems, are system will not work. This year has also been a bad year for storm damage to antennas. The antennas have been replaced and everything is up and running. We have also seen a record numbers of devices logged onto the system more than ever!
