The ECC was not aware that the plantings and beds that are in place around the homes at the Pointe are a requirement of the County and cannot be removed. However, a ground cover can be added in the beds such as pachysandra which will help choke out the weeds along with mulching.

Final inspection letters have been sent out and we are happy to say that we

send out less every year. We did not send out letters for just weeds since they are a constant battle. If you have not been here yet this year, you will already find many in excess of three feet high. Please make arrangements to have them sprayed and removed. Dead weeds are no more attractive then live ones and need to be pulled!

There are many golf carts with flat tires which are in need of repair. Cards

for golf cart dealers and repairs can be found at the front office. Please have your carts fixed and spruce them up so they do not appear unsightly.
