The Bluebird population has increased again this year. We found eggs and babies in several houses. Many are seen in the area around the dog park.

There were two Killdeer nest in the Storage Yard. The first produced four young. They ran around the yard for a few weeks until the babies left the nest. The adults remained and there was second nest. She stayed on the nest of 4 eggs for a couple days but it was lost maybe to predators. Thank you Bo and Pam for making us aware of the nests.

There are many more Robins here than in years past.

A nest of Teal Tree Swallows are new to AP houses this year.

After three years we are finally happy to welcome back the Purple Martins. They are busy and noisy in the house at the middle pond.

A baffle will be placed at the base of the house where a snake was found in the nest. Snakes are predators and will destroy a nest.

The Geese have several families, so cute waddling around the ponds. We've seen only one duck family so far. Enjoy the birds and be sure to visit the Butterfly Way Station. The Butterfly Release is scheduled August 16th.

Pool Committee-Tracey Trott

Both pools opened for Memorial Day weekend on May 24, 2025. The weather didn't cooperate this year so we didn't see many people using the pools. Currently the pools are open from 10 am -6 pm through June 26th . Beginning Friday, June 27th, the pools will remain open until 8 pm. Our popular Friday Night Swims and Hot Dog Nights also begin on Friday, June 27th , the Clubhouse pool will remain open until midnight (weather permitting) and Hot Dog Sales will start at 6:30 and end approximately 9:30 pm. Hot Dogs will be still be sold even if the pool closes due to inclement weather.

Please make sure to lower and tie your umbrella as well as lower your chaise lounge chair backs when you are leaving the pool. This really helps to prevent damage to our pool furnishings. Also, clean up after yourself to help keep our pools clean and tidy. Three paper towel dispensers will be placed in areas around both pools so you can clean up after yourself and help to keep the area clean.

<u>The pools open at 10 am</u>, please do not enter the pool before that time, even if the lifeguard has unlocked the gates. They need time to set up and will not be manning the lifeguard chair until 10 am. Please do not come and save a place with your belongings at your desired sitting area and then leave the pool to return later. The lifeguards have the right to remove belongings from tables and lounge chairs if this happens.

Most importantly, please remember that there is absolutely no glass allowed in or around the pool deck and crab deck areas. This is a Maryland Health Department Rule. If you have glass products, please keep them inside the clubhouse or rec center, both have a refrigerator. Red Solo Cups are available in both buildings for your convenience. Fines will be assessed to homeowners for violations of this rule, so please make sure your family, friends or renters are aware. The office has a good rule sheet and map of the property available if you have family or renters at your home, so please consider picking one up and keeping it visible for visitors.

Spring 2025 inspections went well and the number of properties needing attention is down from last year. The amount of the work in order for properties to comply with our standards, for the most part is minor. Most infractions involved landscaping and clean up. Skirting, siding and Soffit issues also continue to be ones that needs to be frequently addressed.

A reminder to those submitting an ECC application to be patient. It takes time for a review of the request. Each application must receive three signatures prior to being returned to the Assateague Pointe office with approval. It is very helpful to the ECC for the application to be thorough and to include a detailed drawing of the proposed improvement.

HVAC replacement applications require preapproval from Mike Patchett Electrical Service. They are very busy so please be patient and allow ample time for our electrician to review your request. He must have detailed specifications of your proposed HVAC system. Please attach them to your ECC application.

Follow-up property inspections are scheduled for the end of July.

A reminder to all property owners to make sure that your house numbers are present and legible.
