DEADLINE EXTENDED FOR START OF NEW TRADE NAMES/DBA REGISTRATION PROCESS

On May 27, 2025, the State announced that its new state-level process for trade name applications has been delayed from June 2, 2025, to February 2, 2026. The new law will replace Delaware’s current county-level registration process with a single, state-wide registration process that is to be administered by the Delaware Division of Revenue.

The Division said it will use this additional time to ensure that the Department of Revenue’s online trade name registration is as customer friendly as possible, while using modern computer capabilities to maintain Delaware’s Trade Name Registry. The Division plans for additional outreach to current DBA registrants over the summer.
