## 1. Offshore Wind

- The individual expressed concerns about the impacts of emf's from subsea cables may have on species and sediment displacement.
- The Individual also expressed their personal views that the Center has not spoken up/acted and referenced funds previously accepted by wind companies.

## 2. Light Pollution
