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HOW IT WORKS

STEP 1: IDENTIFY

Identify the topics from the program's action framework that interest your community. Consider any relevant issues and/or goals—like wildlife habitat, stormwater management, or waste prevention.

STEP 2: EXPLORE

Review your neighborhood's existing HOA rules or service contracts so everyone understands what's already in place. (No contracts required to participate in Bays to Backyards!)

STEP 3: INQUIRE

Complete the short Inquiry Form to connect with our team and receive next steps and resources.

STEP 4: DEVELOP & IMPLEMENT

Create a 3–5 year Action Plan and start putting your ideas into action.

STEP 5: REPORT & RECOGNIZE

Share your progress each year and earn "Bay-Friendly Community" recognition.
