### MOU with the U.S. State Department

TSF officially signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the U.S. State Department's Bureau of Diplomatic Security. This agreement strengthens our collaboration, further solidifying our role as a trusted convener and partner in building a safer, more secure world.

### • 525+ Programs Funded

### Successful DSAC Annual Meeting & OSAC Annual Briefing Support





The **James W. Foley Legacy Foundation (Foley Foundation)'s** 10th annual Freedom Awards ceremony to advocate for American hostages and wrongful detainees held abroad and promote journalist safety.

"The Security Foundation's generous sponsorship of the James W. Foley Legacy Foundation's 2024 Freedom Awards enabled 68 individuals - including families of Americans held hostage or wrongfully detained abroad, survivors of hostage-taking, and families of Americans who perished in captivity - to participate in the event at no cost. Family members, while in D.C. for the event, were able to conduct meetings arranged by the Foley Foundation with key government personnel to advocate for their loved ones' freedom. These appointments were held with White House officials, members of Congress, the FBI, and Department of State. Many of these officials also attended the Freedom Awards, giving families the opportunity to network with key policymakers and media influencers thereby enabling candid conversations that build relationships and establish trust among those working for the release of Americans unjustly held captive."




