Windmore Public Improvement District Improvement Area #1 – Lot Type 60 HV

Project Overview

Windmore Public Improvement District (the "District") was created by the City Council of the City of Ptinceton (the "City Council" and the "City" respectively) on May 23, 2022, pursuant to the Public Improvement District Assessment Act, Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 372, as amended (the "Act"), and Resolution No. 2022-07-23-R01 upon petition of the owners of the taxable real property representing more than 50 percent of the appraised value of taxable real property liable for assessment within the District and the property owners who own taxable real property that constitutes more than 50 percent of the area of all taxable real property that is liable for assessment by the District.

The District was created principally to finance certain public improvements (the "Authorized Improvements") that specially benefit assessed property in the District. All of the property in the District was located within the corporatg limits of the City of Princeton (the "City"). On October 28, 2024, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2024-10-28-09 that approved a Service and Assessment Plan for the District (the "Service and Assessment Plan") and levied special assessments (the "Assessments") on certain property within the District in accordance with the Assessment Roll attached as Appendix A, to the Service and Assessment Plan. The Assessments may be prepaid in whole or in part at any time or may be paid in annual installments as provided by the Act and the Service and Assessment Plan.

The City issued the Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2024 in the aggregate amount of &4,585,000 pursuant to the Act, Ordinance No. 2024-10-28-10 adopted by the City Council on October 28, 2024 and an Indenture of Trust dated as of November 1, 2024 between the City and Regions Bank

All Assessments that are not paid in full will be billed in annual installments and collected each year by the City, or its designee, as provided in the Service and Assessment Plan. Annual Installments are billed by the Collin County Tax Office and are due and payable as provided on the annual installment assessment bill. Annual installments are expected to be billed and collected on the same schedule as property taxes. The Assessments, including the annual installments thereof, are (a) a first and prior lien against the property assessed, superior to all other liens and claims except liens or claims for state, county, school district or other political subdivision ad valorem property taxes, whether now or hereafter payable, and (b) a personal liability of and charge against the owners of the property to the extent of their ownership regardless of whether the owners are named.

Interest amounts are calculated through the principal payment date each year and include additional interest of one-half of one percent for debt service reserves.
