Edgewood Creek Public Improvement District Phases #2-3 Major Improvement Area Project Overview

Edgewood Creek Public Improvement District (the "District") was created by the City of Celina City Council on May 12, 2020, pursuant to the Public Improvement District Assessment Act, Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 372, as amended (the "Act"), and Resolution No. 2020-33R upon petition of the owners of the taxable real property representing more than 50 percent of the appraised value of taxable real property liable for assessment within the District and the property owners who own taxable real property that constitutes more than 50 percent of the area of all taxable real property that is liable for assessment by the District.

The District was created principally to finance certain public improvements (the "Authorized Improvements") that specially benefit assessed property in the District. All of the property in the District was located within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Celina (the "City") at the time of District creation and was subsequently annexed into the corporate limits of the City. On January 12, 2021, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 2021-02 that approved a Service and Assessment Plan for the District (the "Service and Assessment Plan") and levied special assessments (the "Assessments") on certain property within the District in accordance with the Assessment Roll attached as Appendix E to the Service and Assessment Plan. The Assessments may be prepaid in whole or in part at any time or may be paid in annual installments as provided by the Act and the Service and Assessment Plan.

The City issued the City of Celina Special Assessment Revenue Bonds, Series 2021 (Edgewood Creek Public Improvement District Phases #2-3 Major Improvement Project) (the "Phases #2-3 Major Improvement Bonds") in the aggregate principal amount of \$3,460,000 to finance, refinance, provide or otherwise assist in the acquisition, construction and maintenance of the public improvements provided for the benefit of the property in the PID pursuant to the Act, Ordinance No. 2021-06 adopted by the City Council on January 12, 2021 and an Indenture of Trust dated as of January 1, 2021 between the City and U.S. Bank National Association, as a trustee. The Phases #2-3 Major Improvement Bonds are secured by the Phases #2-3 Assessments (the "Phases #2-3 Assessments").

All Assessments that are not paid in full will be billed in annual installments and collected each year by the City, or its designee, as provided in the Service and Assessment Plan. Annual Installments are billed by the Collin County Tax Office and are due and payable as provided on the annual installment assessment bill. Annual installments are expected to be billed and collected on the same schedule as property taxes. The Assessments, including the annual installments thereof, are (a) a first and prior lien against the property assessed, superior to all other liens and claims except liens or claims for state, county, school district or other political subdivision ad valorem property taxes, whether now or hereafter payable, and (b) a personal liability of and charge against the owners of the property to the extent of their ownership regardless of whether the owners are named.
