During the legislative session that runs January 12 - April 11, 2022, the Chamber will communicate with membership on a weekly basis and include an updated list of bills that may impact our region and member businesses. In

addition, the Government Relations Committee will participate in weekly Zoom sessions with our lobbyist to stay abreast of any changes or action that needs to be taken. We also plan to work closely with our elected officials and strengthen relationships with other statewide legislators who have similar priorities in their districts.
