Unspent Funds	We have \$45,000 in the budget for a peer recovery specialist position,but that position has been put on hold for now. We would like to use these funds to purchase additional Harm Reduction Vending Machines and are looking for suggestions on potential locations. We have a vending machine in production for Deal Island, but there is an issue with the machine having a dedicated power outlet. We are considering placing the vending machine that is in production at UMES until we can figure out the Deal Island situation. Areas to consider include Fairmont, UMES, and the surrounding regions.
