Welcome	Chris Osment called the meeting to order and warmly welcomed everyone.		
Program Updates	CHW update: • We hired a new CHW but it did not work out. • We are still looking to hire a 2 full time contractual CHW.- This will be listed on the state website, our website and Social media • We have been unable to fulfill the Nutritionist and/or Community Health Educator. We are looking to hire a full time nutritionist for the health department supplemented by funding other than HERC. The position would be for the whole health dept Program Update: • Updates on the correct Action Plan three conditions to be met to ensure that the program continues 1. 411 UIS (unduplicated individuals served) by the end of Sept. In just May we served 118 UIS and we are at 310 as of the end of May. We are on track to meet that goal 2. Obtain a license for SCHD to be able to facilitate CDSMP/DSMP classes - We have obtained the License 3. Our personal goal is to train 6 staff members at SCHD. Aves and I are currently taking the leader training. We hope to have Elizabeth and Muhammad enrolled in the next cohort which starts in July.		

	• We have purchased Food Lion gift cards as an incentive to get people to be screened and assessed as part of HEALTH. • \$50 Food Lion gift cards are still being distributed to participants who screen as having food insecurity. The incentive has been very successful. • Mobile Integrated Health Team - Cory is still working on full integration with EMS systems so that we can receive referrals. We have scheduled Tuesdays as our visitation day. This is when the team goes out to visit all of the referrals from the prior week. We are looking into adding a case manager to the team in the future. Garden Project Updates: Elizabeth Justice • The program has been going for a few weeks now and we have already given away 3,000 pounds of vegetables in only a few weeks.
