### **2022 Annual Congregation Meeting Highlights**

February 6, 2022

The meeting was called to order with an opening prayer by Tom Shuster. There were 23 people in attendance at DeWees Hall and 4 people watching via Zoom.

The minutes of the Annual Meeting of February 14, 2021 were approved by voice vote.

Tom Shuster presented the Senior Warden's Report that included a chronology of accomplishments and challenges since the last Annual Meeting. He thanked the current members of the Vestry for their service: Bob Rothermel, John Knotts, Jerilyn Holsten Andrews, Karen Gordon, Kay Ayres and Paul Rogers.

Bob Rothermel presented the Junior Warden's report that highlighted some of the improvements made to church property in 2021 and projects planned by the Buildings and Grounds Committee for 2022.

Paul Rogers presented the end of year financial report of the parish including the expense and revenue reports for parish operations and the community center, and the balance sheet as of December 31, 2021.

Reports were received from all the committees, ministries and outreach programs of the parish and were included in the 2021 Annual Meeting Report. Copies of the report are available from the office.

#### **Ocean Cluster Lenten Project**

The Ocean Cluster of churches, St. Paul's Berlin, St. Paul's bythe-Sea and Church of the Holy Spirit, has not been able to have our three-parish events for the last couple of years, due to Covid. We are anxious to have members of all three churches remember that we are a group, and that when we can, we do things together.


