Highlights from the May 9, 2022 Vestry Meeting

- Approved the minutes of April 18, 2022
- The Vestry discussed the status of the clergy search with the Clergy Search

Committee. Tom Shuster reported that there were no applications as of our

deadline of May 2. The Vestry and Search Committee agreed to readvertise and post the opening on the Episcopal Church

Office of Transition Ministry (OTM)

website following the Vestry meeting of June 13. The Search Committee will reconvene again on May 18 to develop a strategy for increasing applications. The Vestry further decided to update the parish website to be more consistent with the Ministry Portfolio.

- Tom reported that Bishop Santosh Marray has approved the establishment of a commemoration day for Father Dewees. The Vestry discussed possible dates for the commemoration and considered selecting either April 24 or August 24, 2023.
- Vestry reviewed the 2022 Worship Schedule through Sunday, August 28. Pastors Blake and Karen Wamester will be serving as supply clergy. Morning Prayer will be provided on selected Sundays when supply clergy are not available.
- Three parishioners have agreed to serve on the Sunday Attendance Focus Group to review recent trends in Average Sunday Attendance (ASA) and formulate ideas for stimulating more interest in attendance. Parishioners interested in participating in the Focus Group should contact Tom Shuster.
- Bob Rothermel reported that the Buildings & Eamp; Grounds Committee will be prioritizing the 6 Year Capital Improvements Project List (2022-2027) that was presented to the Vestry at the April meeting. A priority list will be forwarded to the Vestry and Finance Committee.
- Paul Rogers presented his last Treasurer's report as of May 9, 2022. The Vestry thanked Paul for his service and welcomed John Knotts to serve out the balance of his term. Paul also reported that a financial review of the 2021 fiscal year is planned.
- Cheryl Nottingham reported on the Finance Committee meeting of May 4. Paul Rogers will continue to serve on the Committee as a Vestry representative and John Knotts will serve on the committee as the Treasurer. Karen Gordon will also serve on the Committee as a Vestry member.
- Received a status report on the Parish Marketing Plan for 2022-2023 from Jody Farley
 - Set the next Vestry meeting for Monday, June 13, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. at church.




