#### **Highlights from the July 18th Vestry Meeting**

- · Approved the minutes of June 13, 2022
- The Vestry accepted the recommendation of the Search Committee to approve the revised Ministry Portfolio and readvertise and post the clergy opening on the Episcopal Church Office of Transition Ministry (OTM) website with a closing date of October 31, 2022. The Vestry also adopted a revised Clergy Search Charge to incorporate the new dates. Cami Rogers, Search Committee Chair, will follow up with Canon Patrick Collins.
- The Vestry discussed possible dates for the commemoration of Father Dewees and considered selecting either April 24 or August 24, 2023. The Vestry selected April 24 for the annual commemoration beginning in 2023.
- · Vestry reviewed the 2022 Worship Schedule. Tom Shuster has recruited supply clergy into October.
- Bob Rothermel reported on the status of several Buildings & Grounds projects. The Vestry approved some drain spout improvements at the community center and HVAC repairs at the church.
- · John Knotts presented the Treasurer's report as of June 20, 2022. John reported on the Bank of Ocean City stock held by the church and its value.
- · Cheryl Nottingham reported on the Finance Committee meeting of July 12. The next Committee meeting will be September 12.
- Received a status report from Jody Farley on the status of the redesign of the parish website. The Vestry had approved the redesign work with D<sub>3</sub> at the June meeting.
- Tom Shuster reported that Any Diaz has shared his desire to pursue the discernment process for ordination. The Vestry heard a briefing from Debbie Shuster, a member of the Commission on Ministry, about the discernment process. The Vestry supported Andy in his desire to pursue discernment.
- · Set the next Vestry meeting for Monday, August 15, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. at church.


