- · Vestry confirmed plans to celebrate the Commemoration of Father William Dewees on Monday, April 24, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. with a reception to follow at Dewees Hall.
- Tom Shuster reported that Andy Diaz has agreed to serve as the Vestry Liaison on the Sunday Attendance Focus Group along with Debbie Shuster, Jody Farley and Brian Connor. Other parish members are encouraged to participate.
- Bob Rothermel presented the 2022-2028 Capital Improvements and Major Repairs Projects list developed by the Buildings & Grounds Committee. The Vestry approved the projects list and agreed to fund the remaining 2022 projects from the current budget.

This Sunday please bring toiletry items with you to church to be distributed to the clients of Shepherd's Crook.


