Who is our light in the world so that we no longer walk in darkness. May our lives be a light to others. *Amen*.








Mitten & Scarves

The food will be placed on the tables, family style, so everyone can enjoy each other's company. As always, since the beginning of NOEL, a feeding ministry of St. Paul's by-the-Sea Episcopal Church, all



are welcome at the Christmas Day dinner. We will never turn anyone away. This will be a safe, loving place to gather whether you are hungry for food or companionship. Our dinner unites a diverse community – from those who are in need of a meal, to our homeless brothers and sisters, to those who find themselves alone on Christmas Day. We all become one family at one table.

However, this year, there will not be a need to distribute pantry items, toiletries, hats, gloves, scarves, etc., to those who attend this dinner.
