VIII. Department Head Report

Town Manager

-The Town and DR Horton finalized agreement to repair damaged roads in Somerset Landing.

-The Town had its last Sustainable Communities Committee meeting. We are preparing to submit our application.

-The Town is interviewing lifeguards for the summer swim program at UMES.

-The Town through a grant awarded to Main Street Princess will receive grant funds to increase security at Parks and the Main Street District.

Public Works

-Public works department collected 78.5 tons of trash for the month of June.

-The Roads Division filled the big potholes on Drexwood Drive with crush n run and asphalt.

-Public Works did curb and gutter clean up on Beechwood, Washington, and Irving streets.

-The Juneteenth parade and cleaned all town properties and parking lots for the event along with other duties.

Police Department

-Chief Wink attended the Somerset Child Advocacy Center board meeting.

-Chief Wink attended regular town meeting.

- PAPD hosted a local high school paranormal activity club at the Grey Eagle
- Members of PAPD attended Cpl Hilliard's funeral.
- Lt Smith attended the Law Enforcement Expo
- PAPD conducted in house training on Law updates and judgmental scenarios.
- PAPD handled 543 calls for service in June. 2% of the incidents remain open/under investigation while 98% are closed either by arrest, other, or unfounded. PAPD issued 92 traffic citations, 139 warnings, and 5 safety equipment repair orders. 1 DUI's, burglaries, 8 assaults, 4 emergency petitions, 7 thefts and 6 motor vehicle collisions.
- Monthly grant invoices/reports were completed for the SCOUT, Tobacco, Alcohol and Somerset County Recovery Court grants and FY end reports are being generated for these. PAPD is continuing to re-apply for these. PAPD is continuing to re-apply for grants through GOCCP and other granting agencies.

- Carrie Samis, Main Street Director: Signed grant agreement the funds are not available yet.
- Dale Parker, President of CROPA: Congratulated to all election winners. Thanked Town staff and Police Department. Looking forward to working with the town.
- Cindy Perry, Somerset Landing: Asked to have the lifeguard position advertised on town social media.
- John Hurst Chamber of Commerce: In the process of defining the chamber bylaws and other various things. Excited to develop with businesses in Town.
- Tri-County Council: Would like to bring a Youth Development program into town.
- April Alexander: Apart of Positive Reinforcement which is a nonprofit community-based resource program that offers support to formerly incarcerated individuals.

Commissioner Shelley Johnson: Gave a brief introduction of herself and will be looking forward to working with everyone in the community.

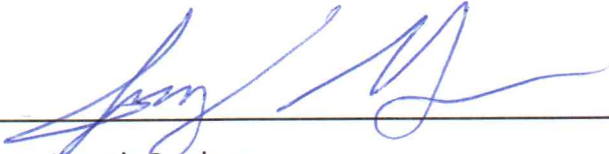
Vice President: Congratulated the new officers, thanked the public works department and town office staff.

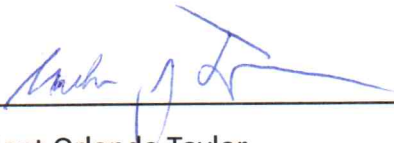
President Gardner: Thanked all commissioners and Town departments. At each meeting we would like to set up the agenda for the next meeting so the agenda can be published in a timely manner.

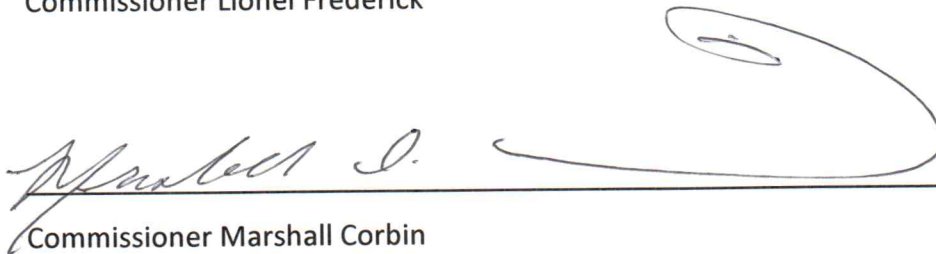

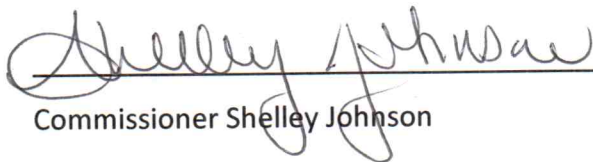

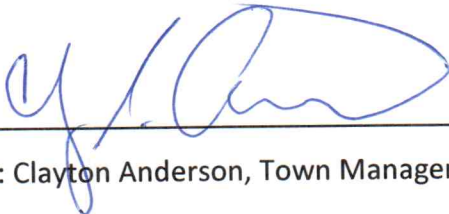
