

## Rules and Regulations of the Old Wye Church Columbarium

The following Rules and Regulations for the Columbarium are promulgated by the Vestry of Old Wye Parish in Wye Mills, Talbot County, Maryland (herein called "Vestry") subject to amendment from time to time.

1. Niches shall be numbered consecutively, number one (1) being the niche in the south wall.
2. Interment License Fee: The Interment License Fee shall consist of an initial fee to be paid at the time of completion of an Application for the Internment License and Agreement. If the application is approved by the Vestry, the completed application with accompanying fee will reserve the right of a License Holder to the use of a Standard Niche Space.
3. The initial fee of \$1200 is subject to change by the Vestry upon sixty (60) days notice from date of mailing to the members of the Parish. This fee is for one (1) niche, which holds up to two (2) urns.
  - a. Each niche space is 14-1/8" high, 10-3/8" deep and 10-3/8" wide, and is designed to hold the remains of no more than two (2) decedents, i. e., two (2) urns, each of the approximate dimensions: 9" x 6" x 4". The front cover is 16" x 12". Plans and specifications may be examined at the Parish Office.
  - b. The subsequent fee shall be that sum of money set forth from time to time by the vestry in the rules and regulations in effect at the time of interment. Until the same is amended by the Vestry, the said fee shall be \$1200.
