  - o 29 have been non-fatal.
  - o 6 have been fatal
- This is a 22% decrease in overall numbers and is a 60% decrease in fatalities.
- There are no new trends to report.
- They are still monitoring medetomidine (which is more potent than xylazine) and other adulterants in the local supply.
