#### Wicomico County Sheriff's Department

- Jaime Greves reported via email that to date in 2025 there have been 49 total Law Enforcement Reported Overdoses.
  - o 40 have been non-fatal.
  - o 8 have been fatal
  - o 1 pending testing results
- Wicomco County overdoses are down 18% from this time last year and fatal overdoses are down 60%
